REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
Tuesday, September 6, 2022

The regular meeting of the Garrison City Council was held Tuesday September 6, 2022, at 6 pm. The meeting was held at the Garrison Public Library. Mayor Flickinger presided. Council members present: Tina Rommann, Al Lindsey, and Doug Kearns via phone in. Absent: Decker and Trimble. City Clerk, Angela Dague recorded the minutes.

- Rommann moved to approve the agenda, seconded by Lindsay. Ayes: All. Nays: None. Motion carried.
- Lindsey moved to approve the consent agenda, seconded by Kearns. Ayes: All. Nays: None. Motion carried.

- Kent Kirchner
 - Discussion on property vacated without paying utility bill
- Public Comment
 - Kevin Kistler had questions about city lots for sale and cleanup of vehicles.
- Departments gave reports/comments
 - Mayor – No comment
 - Public Safety – No report
 - Attorney – advised on fence lines and nonpayment of utility bills
 - Maintenance/Roads – crack seal is done on county highway, discussion on future ditch work, grass blown in street
 - Public Works – trees need to be cut at lagoon, we had a DNR inspection – results not in, pump 2 is not running-Iowa Pump Works will come out.
 - BC Development – budget has to be redone as Iowa and Benton counties separated partnership.
 - Park – discussion on cameras for the park and where to place. Whether to put roof on bathroom and concession stand
 - Library – Idiot Jam is Sept 10, kids programming will start end of September.
 - Fire Dept. – convention was happening, Garrison’s Haunted prep will begin
 - Administrative – discussion on selling 100 E Maple property – not at present. Discussion on prorating set amounts on utility bills for those who move out/in. We had quite a few liens paid via county taxes collected
- Old Business:
 - Seal coat/friction coat – decision was made to wait until next year when county does it for a possible better bid.
- New Business:
 - Lindsey moved to accept the fire hydrant replacement bid of \$2500 by Hatch Grading and Contracting, seconded by Rommann. Ayes: All. Nays: None. Motion carried.
 - Kearns introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption, seconded by Rommann. Roll Call vote: Ayes: Rommann, Lindsey, Kearns. Nays: None. Absent: Trimble, Decker. Where upon the Mayor declared the following duly adopted: Resolution No. 2022-12, entitled “Resolution to Authorize the Transfer of Funds” – Passed and approved this 6th day of September 2022.

- The city will not charge the trail for water usage at the drinking water station. A meter will be put in for DNR purposes.
- A proposal will be brought in for the next sewer lining blocks.

Rommann moved to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Lindsey. Ayes: All. Nays: None. Motion carried. There being no further business before council, Mayor Flickinger adjourned the meeting at 8:27 pm.
