REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
Monday, November 4, 2024

The regular meeting of the Garrison City Council was held Monday, November 4, 2024, at 6:00 pm. The meeting was held at the Garrison Public Library. Mayor Flickinger presided.  - Lindsey moved to approve the clerk attending the Annual Budget Workshop on November 19, seconded by Kearns. Ayes: All. Nays: None. Motion carried.
