REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
Monday, October 2, 2023

The regular meeting of the Garrison City Council was held Monday, October 2, 2023, at 6 pm. The meeting was held at the Garrison Public Library. Mayor Flickinger presided. Council members present: Tina Rommann, Al Lindsey, Marvin Trimble, Robert Decker, and Doug Kearns. City Clerk, Angela Dague recorded the minutes.

- Trimble moved to approve the agenda, seconded by Kearns. Ayes: All. Nays: None. Motion carried.
- Decker moved to approve the consent agenda, seconded by Rommann. Ayes: All. Nays: None. Motion carried.

- Public Comment –
  - Kaylea Marquez requested information on putting up a fence at 406 E Maple St.
  - Rommanns asked about the process of weed/grass complaints and commented on city properties that are not kept up.
- Departments gave reports/comments.
  - Mayor – none
  - Public Safety (sheriff/fire) – Fire Dept will be having Haunted this month and Fire Prevention, there was a request for new photo for paper.
  - Attorney – none
  - Enforcement – We will follow through with nuisance letters that were sent and not complied to
  - Maintenance/Roads – Paving is finished, City will do the alleyway themselves, roller and oiler need to be fixed so the City can do their own roads. They have the oil.
  - Public Works – Posts need to be ordered and bids collected for fence at lagoon, utility at 200 Elm needs to be checked as there is usage and shouldn't be.
  - Park – Greg Wilson will have a contract written up for ball diamond area, water needs to be shut off at park.
  - Library – library hours have changed, kids' programs have started, concert at Merc on 22<sup>nd</sup> @ 2
  - BC Development –no report
  - Administrative – Street Finance Report is finished, Annual Report is next, still working in beta for new utility program.
- Business Items:
  - Trimble moved to approve Keystone Communications to move the fiber optics in the alleyway between Spruce and Walnut, seconded by Lindsey. Ayes: All. Nays: None. Motion carried.
  - Some old meters need to be replaced and new ones put in. The City will have a plumber come in to do that. Letters will be sent to those who need replacements.
  - No motion was made to approve the flared culver intakes.
  - The sidewalks on the corner of Oak and Linden and on the corner of Oak and Locust need to be poured. Members of Council will form and pour.
  - The code meeting will be October 16 @ 6 pm.

Decker moved to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Rommann. Ayes: All. Nays: None. Motion carried. There being no further business before council, Mayor Flickinger adjourned the meeting at 8:06 pm.
