  - Agreement with Fire Department
    - Trimble moved to approve a 25% payment increase to the Garrison Fire Department for their services to the community, seconded by Rommann. Ayes: All. Nays: None. Motion carried.
  - o Sewer rate discussion
    - Lindsey proposed to change the structure of the sewer rate from first 5000 to first 1500 gallons and an additional cost per 1000 gallons, with cost the same for residential and commercial, seconded by Decker. Ayes: All. Nays: None. Motion carried.
    - All residents will be billed for sewer usage, storm drainage and sewer debt regardless of water usage status.
  - Farmer's Mercantile sidewalk
    - The Council determined they cannot fundraise for the Mercantile but will look for grants that may help in the cost of Mercantile's sidewalk repair.
  - o Registration fee for Lead Class for Operator by Affidavit
    - Decker moved to approve paying the full \$100 fee for the lead class if Garrison is the only city he services, and half of the cost if he services another town, seconded by Rommann. Ayes: All. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Lindsey moved to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Decker. Ayes: All. Nays: None. Motion carried. There being no further business before council, Mayor Flickinger adjourned the meeting at 8:06 pm.
