- Lindsey moved to approve Prairie Road Builder's quote of \$3316.30, seconded by Decker. Ayes: All. Nays: None. Motion carried.
- Trimble moved to approve hiring Danny Dvorak to do the nuisance mowing for the City of Garrison, seconded by Rommann. Ayes: All. Nays: None. Motion carried.
- Rommann moved to approve turning on internet at the park for cameras, seconded by Lindsey. Ayes: All. Nays: None. Motion carried.
- Build permit - Basso
 - Trimble moved to approve Basso's build permit, seconded by Rommann. Ayes: All. Nays: None. Motion carried.
- Build permit - Hird
 - Lindsey moved to approve Hird's build permit, seconded by Decker. Ayes: All. Nays: None. Motion carried.
- Vacating the alley/easement on Linden:
 - Lindsey moved to vacate the alley/easement on S. Linden Ave and split the property in half and award the halves to the abutting property owners, Darrell Peterson and Barry Meyers, seconded by Decker. Both parties are in agreement. Ayes: All. Nays: None. Motion carried.
