All items must be brought by the homeowner to the clean-up site located at the intersection of Hickory Street and Beech Ave

ALL ITEMS MUST BE PAID FOR AT THE UNLOADING SITE

The City WILL take the following items:

- *Batteries *Scrap metal *Old furniture/household items - All NO charge
- *Large appliances (washers, dryers, freezers, refrigerators, etc) - \$10
- *Small appliances (dehumidifiers, air conditioners, microwaves, etc) - \$5
- *Televisions, according to size: Flat screen – no charge, under 19” - \$5, 19” – 25” - \$10
26” and over - \$15, console/big screen projection - \$20
- *Large copiers/printers/fax machines - \$15 Home desktop towers, printers, etc- no charge
- *Monitors: up to 19” - \$5 over 19” - \$10 Flat screen – no charge
- *Gas grill LP tanks - \$5 Small torch propane cylinders - \$1
- *Car/pick up tires - \$5 Truck tire - \$15 Super single tire - \$20 Farm tire - \$50

The City WILL NOT take the following items:

- *Construction/building materials/sinks/toilets/doors/windows *Asbestos
- *Recyclables *Regular trash *Any item that the weekly garbage truck will pick up
- *Brush/yard waste
